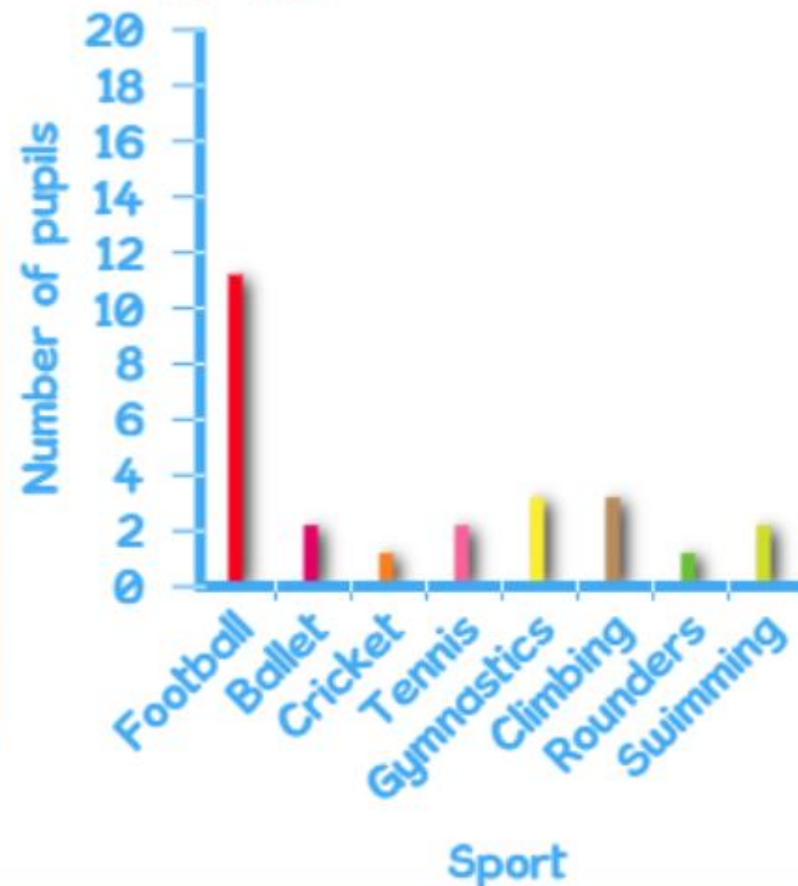

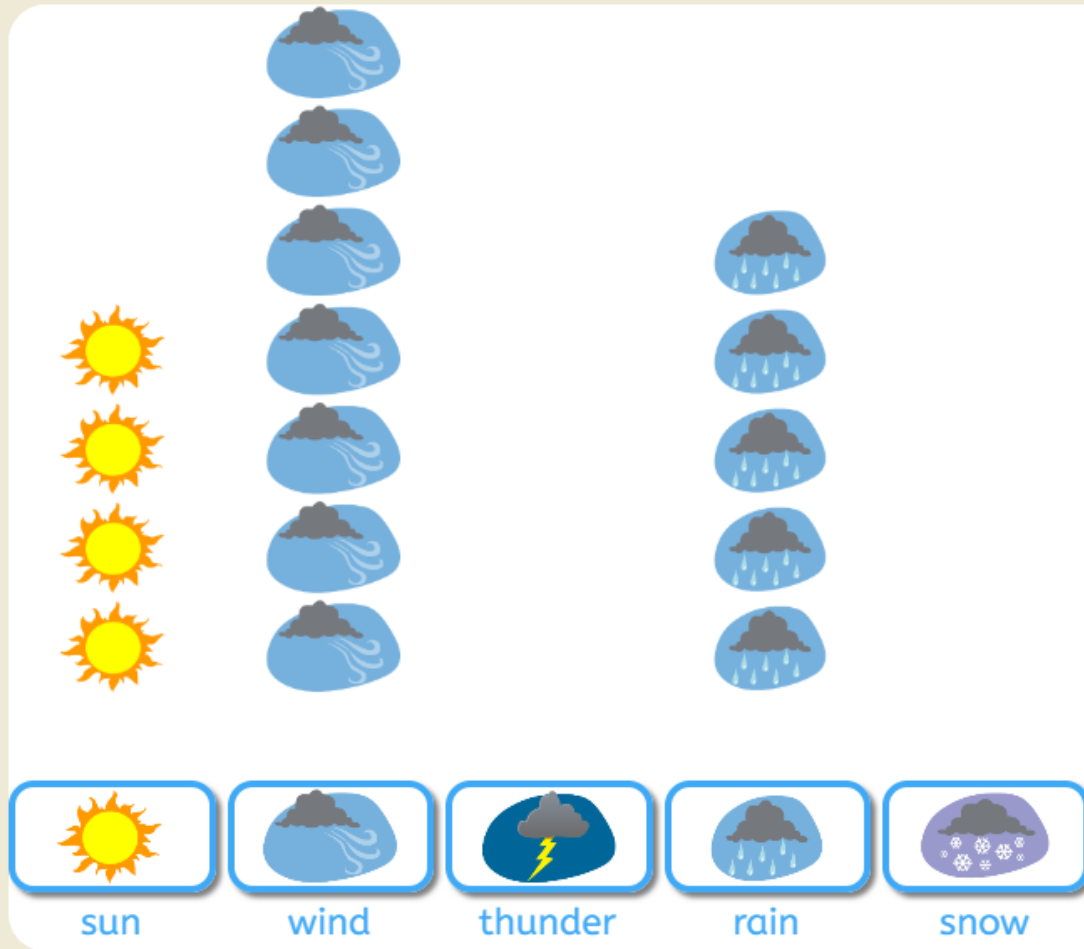
This is my drawing of Carmel Chapel. It was built in the 1800's.
